

Directions to Havra

From Sumburgh Airport

Leave the airport and take the A970 (signposted Lerwick) north for approximately 5 miles to the B9122.

Before this, at the Quendale junction you pass Mainland's shop and petrol station on your left.

Turn left into the B9122 which is signposted Scousburgh and Bigton.

Keep on this road for approx 3.5 miles. At the junction for Bigton (end of the straight mile), keep right, which takes you round the back of the Bigton church and hall.

Turn left at the next junction (signposted Bigton and St Ninians Isle).

Down the hill to the next junction (signposted Maywick) – bus shelter on your left.

Turn right into the Maywick road – drive for 2 miles (past the Vatsetter Loch).

Havra is the red roofed semi-detached cottage on your left.

Parking down the drive.



The B9122 is mainly a single track road with passing places.

There is another route.

If you wish you can keep on the A970 until you reach the other end of the B9122 approx 9.5 miles from the airport. Turn left at the junction (signposted Bigton, Scousburgh and Spiggie). Drive over the peat hill for 1.2 miles to the next junction.

Turn right (signposted Bigton and St Ninians Isle).

Down the hill to the next junction (signposted Maywick) – bus shelter on your left.

Turn right into the Maywick road – drive for 2 miles (past Vatsetter Loch).

Havra is the red roofed semi-detached cottage on your left.

Parking down the drive.

From Lerwick Ferry Terminal

From the terminal turn left into Holmsgarth Road.

Keep right at the mini-roundabout (signposted Town Centre).

Right at the next roundabout (signposted The South).

Straight across next roundabout and keep on the south road- A970.

Drive for approx 14 miles until you reach the Bigton junction (signposted Bigton, Scousburgh and Spiggie).

Turn right into the B9122 and drive over the peat hill for 1.2 miles to the next junction.

Turn right (signposted Bigton and St Ninians Isle).

Down the hill to the next junction (signposted Maywick) – bus shelter on your left.

Turn right into the Maywick road – drive for 2 miles (past Vatsetter Loch).

Havra is the red roofed semi-detached cottage on your left.

Parking down the drive.
